Komuroyama Ridge Walk "MISORA"



Access from Ito Station, fare 510 yen
From Ito Station Bus Stop (1), (3), or (5), take the bus bound for "Komuroyama Lift" or "Shaboten Koen via Komuroyama"
(Line No.: I05, I22, I67)
and get off at "Komuroyama Lift".

A scenery point of Izu at the top of Komuroyama, Ito City was opened in April 2021. Ride the cute retro lift for one and go to the top of the mountain and stand on the boardwalk encircling the top of the mountain. See the endless sea and sky. If you look in the opposite direction, you can see the city of Ito, and even Mt. Fuji on a clear day.

In addition, "Café•321" is built on the top of the mountain and offers an all-ocean & sky view. You can relax inside the cafe with its gentle colors inspired by geological strata, and the private wood deck exclusively for cafe guests.
*Lifts may be closed due to bad weather.



Omuroyama

580m tall Mt. Omuro is an Izu, Ito, and Izu Kogen landmark. Take the 1km long mountaintop walking trail. From the top of the mountain, enjoy a spectacular 360-degree panoramic view including Mt. Fuji and the Izu Islands.
*Lifts may be closed due to bad weather.

Access from Ito Station, fare 880 yen
From Ito Station Bus Stop (5), take the bus bound for "Shaboten Koen"
(Line No.: I61, I64, I65, I66, I67) and get off at the last stop, "Shaboten Koen".

Access from Izu Kogen Station, fare 430 yen
From Ito Station Bus Stop (1), take the bus bound for "Shaboten Koen"
(Line No.: I70-I73) and get off at the last stop, "Shaboten Koen".

Jogasaki Beach



Access from Ito Station, fare 860 yen
From Ito Station Bus Stop (3) take the bus bound for "Izu Kaiyo Koen" or "Izu Kogen"
(Line No.: I31-I33), get off at Jogasaki bus stop. 15 min. walk

Access from Izu Kogen Station, fare 300 yen
From Izu Kogen Station Bus Stop (2), take the bus bound for "Izu Kaiyo Koen" (Line No.: I70, I80) and get off on the last stop "Izu Kaiyo Koen", 15 min. walk



Jogasaki Beach was formed by a lava flow when Mt. Omuro erupted approximately 4,000 years ago. As you follow the picnic course toward the rope bridge, the open prairie spreads out. Enjoy the grass and flowers blooming at your feet. "Kadowaki Bridge" is a thrilling experience that will refresh you. If you are afraid of heights, it may scare you a bit...

Izu Shaboten Zoo



Access from Ito Station, fare 880 yen
From Ito Station Bus Stop (5), take the bus bound for "Shaboten Koen"
(Line No.: I61, I64, I65, I66, I67) and get off at the last stop, "Shaboten Koen".

Access from Izu Kogen Station, fare 430 yen
From Ito Station Bus Stop (1), take the bus bound for "Shaboten Koen"
(Line No.: I70-I73) and get off at the last stop, "Shaboten Koen".

Theme park featuring animals and cactus, the capybaras and squirrel monkeys are famous. There are many places where visitors can interact with the animals up close, as well as animal shows that can be enjoyed by both adults and children.

Tokaikan (Ito City Tangible Cultural Heritage) Constructed in 1928, this was a three-story Japanese inn (currently open as a tourist facility). In this Japanese-style building, you can feel that atmosphere of the day. Enjoy viewing the beautiful architecture, including the 120-tatami mat grand hall, and the detailed wooden mosaic paper screens and display windows constructed with traditional Japanese techniques by the craftsmen of the time.
